C. COMMERCIAL ISSUES

C.30 Long Term Access for Vishnugad Pipalkoti HEP (444 MW) (Agenda by THDCIL)

C.30.1 THDCIL is implementing Vishnugad Pipalkoti HEP (444 MW) in Garhwal, Himalayas. The construction work at the project is in full swing. The Power generated from the project shall be supplied to all state/UT of Northern Region. The PPAs for the entire power have been signed with Haryana, Rajasthan, UT of Chandigarh, Punjab, Rajasthan, J&K, Uttarahand, Himachal Pradesh Delhi's Discoms viz. BRPL and TPDDL.

C.30.2 The Power, has been allocated to the beneficiaries by Ministry of Power , Government of India vide their letter 11/28/2008 H-1 dtd 26.12.2011 as under :

C.30.3 In accordance with the applicable Connectivity Regulations 2009 of the Hon'ble CERC the beneficiaries are required to apply for Long Term Access (LTA) and subsequently sign Long Term Access Agreement (LTAA) with PGCIL which is laying the transmission system in association with PTCUL for the Vishnugad Pipalkoti HEP. Beneficiaries are required to apply for Long Term Access to PGCIL at the earliest. The beneficiaries have been requested to apply for the LTA through various correspondences. The delay in applying for LTA is delaying the transmission system work.

C.30.4 So far, UP Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL) and Uttarakhand Power Corporation Limited (UPCL) have authorized THDCIL to apply for LTA to PGCIL on their behalf.

- UT Chandigarh is directly corresponding with PGCIL in this regard.
- J&K has informed that they will take up the said matter with PGCIL directly.

C.30.5 There is no positive response from Rajasthan, Punjab, Haryana, HP, Delhi Discoms (TPDDL and BRPL).

C.30.6 In view of the aforesaid, the above beneficiaries are requested to immediately either apply directly to PGCIL for Long Term Access or authorize THDC India Ltd in this forum to apply for Long Term Access (LTA) to PGCIL on their behalf.

D.7.2 As per amended resolution dated 09.05.2008 of Government of India, Ministry of Power regarding establishment of the Northern Regional Power Committee, provides for regular representation for Generating companies other than central generating companies or State Government owned generating companies having more than 1000 MW installed capacity in the region. Prayagraj Power Generation Co Ltd. had informed that they have 1980 MW capacity in their plant in Tehsil Bara, District Allahabad, UP and requested for regular membership in NRPC. Similarly Nabha

Power Limited had informed that they have 1400 MW capacity in their plant in Rajpura in Punjab State and requested for regular membership in NRPC.

- D.7.3 As per amended resolution dated 09.05.2008 of Government of India, Prayagraj Power Generation Co Ltd.(PPGCL) and Nabha Power Limited (NPL) can be included as a regular member of NRPC from 1st April, 2017.
