## Minutes of meeting held on 08.08.2013 to discuss issues in Energy Accounting under Renewable Regulatory Fund (RRF)

List of participants is enclosed at Annexure – I.

Member Secretary, NRPC, welcomed the participants. He stated that as per Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) order dated 09.07.2013, the mechanism of Renewable Regulatory Fund was to be implemented from 15.07.2013. All accounts related to accounting of UI from pooling stations of Wind and Solar Stations had to be prepared by concerned RPCs on a weekly basis based on inputs from the NRLDC. However, no data had been received in NRPC Sectt. for preparation of said accounts.

Representative of NRLDC stated that they were yet to receive data from the SLDCs. He stated that NRLDC require injection schedule at each pooling station, breakup of schedule to different states and actual injection data on 15-minute basis.

Representative of NLDC stated that as per procedure for implementation of the mechanism of Renewable Regulatory Fund Coordinating Agency was to be appointed by wind and solar generators connected to pooling station. This Coordinating Agency could be one of the generator or any other mutually agreed agency who would be responsible for coordinating with concerned SLDC/RLDC etc on behalf of all the developers on issues like SCADA, metering, scheduling, UI charges, Renewable Regulatory Fund. NLDC representative enquired whether SLDC Rajasthan had received declaration from wind/solar generators regarding coordinating agencies.

Representative of SLDC Rajasthan stated that they had received the information regarding coordinating agencies for solar generators through NVVN. The twenty one number of pooling stations had been decided for solar generators and nine numbers for wind generators. He also stated that they were getting pooling station wise schedule data but not receiving 15-minute wise actual injection data on weekly basis. He further stated that the details of coordinating agencies and respective pooling stations would be furnished to NRLDC/NRPC.

Representative of RVPNL informed that the ABT meters had already been installed at most of the pooling stations.

Representative of NVVNL intimated the LTA had been taken for inter-state / inter regional transfer of 210 MW Solar Power from Rajasthan & requested NRPC look into the matter for allocations of coal power for bundling with NVVNL Solar Power. Member Secretary, NRPC stated that the issue regarding Andhra Pradesh declining to take their allocation had already been referred to CEA/MoP for their advice.

It was agreed that SLDC Rajasthan would hold a meeting with pooling stations/ coordinating agencies decided by project developers and impress upon them to furnish the scheduled/actual injection to SLDC for further transmission to NRLDC/NRPC as required under the procedure for implementation of the mechanism of Renewable Regulatory Fund.

The meeting ended with thanks to Chair.
